1. A separate submission form : Must accompany each poster/s submitted naming all the submitted poster if more than one. All information should be completed in English along with a title and a brief description of the poster/s you are submitting, and your biography a maximum of 250 words.

2. Entry Poster/s : Entry posters should be submitted as low-res files at 700×980 pixels. **Resolution:** 72 dpi, **Color Mode:** RGB, **File Format:** JPEG or PNG (*Please keep the original high-res file. We will ask you to send us if you are one of the selected*).

I promise that:

- no claims, litigation or other proceedings have been asserted and/or brought, no claims, litigation or proceedings are pending or threatened relating to the work.
- the work is original to me;
- the reproduction of the work will not infringe the rights of others;
- I agree to pay any costs or damages ‘International Reggae Poster Contest’ might incur as a result of my breach of this clause.

Short biography:

Artists/Designers will retain all rights to their original posters art. The International Reggae Poster Contest shall have an irrevocable, perpetual, non-exclusive, transferable, royalty-free, worldwide licence to use, copy, exhibit, publicly display and distribute their submitted entry for any activity, reproduce and distribute to third parties that are associated or sponsored activities. The International Reggae Poster Contest shall have the right to reproduce and distribute to third parties the International Reggae Poster Contest catalogue/book in unlimited quantities. The IRPC will notify specifically designers for other use where necessary and request a mutual agreement based on a written authorization. A fee or a royalty, as agreed with the designer or designers will be refund to the artwork owners. Designers are guaranteed the right to be credited every time their entry is used or published. The name and surname will be mentioned approximate to the used artwork.
